

## Proposed By-Law Change – Dicussion for February 2024 Membership Meeting

## **ARTICLE II- MEMBERSHIP**

### **SECTION 4: LEAVE OF ABSENCE**

Any member in good standing may apply to the Board of Directors for an absolute leave of absence. If such application is granted by a majority of the Board, such person's membership, together with the rights, privileges, and dues shall be suspended.

Said person shall have the right to apply to the Board for reinstatement to the same classification held by him at the time of taking leave; and the Board shall cause his readmission within one month following the filing of such application with the Corresponding Secretary, subject to the terms and conditions set forth herein. In the event that the Board of Directors grants a Member a leave of absence, the Member can not apply for readmission within 18 months of the leave of absence being granted unless such leave was requested due to military service. The Board of Directors, at its discretion, may approve other extenuating circumstances whereby a Member may apply for, and obtain readmittance, prior to the 18-month period elapsing. The maximum allowable period for a leave of absence is ten years, but the Board of Directors, at its discretion, may approve an extension of the ten- year period based on extenuating circumstances.

After a Member's leave of absence period has expired, the Member shall no longer be a Member of the Club and all of the Member's seniority rights are terminated. If the former member opts to reapply to the Club, he/she must pay all applicable application fees and dues and will be considered a new member.

In the event of failure of any person to so file his application, his membership and all rights to reinstatement shall be automatically forfeited.

### ARTICLE VII - COMMITTEES

#### SECTION 1: STANDING COMMITTEES

Subject to the supervision of the Board of Directors and the provisions hereof, the operative affairs of the Club shall be promoted by and subject to the work of the following standing committees:
