# BLAST FROM THE PAST



In the summer of 1984 By-Law changes were made approving the admittance of female members. On August 9,1984. Shirley Brown was voted in to the Club as an Apprentice Member. Club By-laws were also changed permitting spousal use of the Club (as approved) without their mate being present. In 1985, Flag Membership classification was voted in, which

permitted the spouse of a deceased member to join SYC, and therefore continue to use the Club on a social basis. These membership changes have been very beneficial to SYC. The women who have since joined as Apprentice, Associate and Flag Members have contributed to much of the Club's success.

# THE ISLAND GOATS SAILING SOCIETY MEETS AT SYC



If you're not familiar with the Island Goats Sailing Society, it is a non-profit organization of sailors that have completed 25 or more Chicago to Mackinac Island sail boat races. Many Mac Racers aspire to be an Island Goat or even the designation of Master Mariner which are those that have completed 50 or more Mac Races. Peter "The Bear" Reichelsdorfer is the only Master Mariner at SYC or the state of WI for that matter. There are plaques on the north wall of the bar that recognizes SYC members that are Island Goats as well as Peter as a Master Mariner. I have been an Island Goat board member the last four years, in May I was nominated to the Flag as the Island Goat Secretary.

While there are Island Goats in WI, MI and IN, as you can imagine most Island Goats call the Chicago area home. Historically all Island Goat gatherings had been in either Chicago or on Mackinac Island after the race. As an Island Goat Flag Officer my goal is reaching many Island Goats that live in WI, MI and IN, especially those that no longer do the race and give them opportunity to gather and share racing stories and a beer.

On Sunday, September 10th the first Island Goat Sailing Society gathering outside Chicago or Mackinac Island was held at Sheboygan Yacht Club





sponsored by Peroni Beer. It was attended by 18 WI Island Goats which represents about a third of all WI Island Goats with Mike Schultz coming the most distance from Waukesha. It also gave us opportunity to announce in person the 2023 Boat Load of Goats award to the crew of Main Street with combined total 230 Mac years among the seven Island Goats on their crew. They include Bill Schanen III (39), Dale Peters (35), Bill Schanen IV (34), Rich Reichelsdorfer (34), Greta Schanen (32), Erin Schanen (31) and Bill Faude (27).

As usual Sean and the SYC staff did a great job hosting the IGSS Brats and Beer event with a good menu and great food. A lot of appreciation from the group for bringing the event to WI and look to build momentum for similar events in MI and future WI events.


