Pier Party

Hello SYC Members,

We are planning to winterize the piers on Saturday October 31st from 8 a.m.—noon. The alternate date will be Saturday November 7th if the weather doesn't cooperate.

This should go quickly this year as the piers are as high as possible and should not need to be adjusted. All boats will need to be out of the water by this time or you will be responsible for your own pier.

This task requires a minimum of eight to twelve people to complete the following:

DE-ICERS—Install all de-icers on the finger piers

- Haul de-icers up from SYC basement to garage
- Run Power cords on each pier
- Fasten wood plank on each pier
- Hang de-icer from wood planks on each pier
- Plug in and test each de-icer

FLOATING DOCKS—The two floating docks are to be hoisted and stored for the winter along the north fence. Also lifting and stowing the ramp to the floating dock requires four to five people.

WATER LINES—All the water lines will be shut off and winterized on or before November 7th. Please let me know if you wouldn't mind doing a small amount of plumbing for winterization.

NOTE: If you keep your boat in the basin, please help winterize our piers.

We are also looking for four to six volunteers to help monitor de-icers throughout the winter. Each volunteer will be assigned one- to two-week intervals of reviewing the de-icers daily for freeze-ups. Please email mech@csacommercial.com to sign up or call my cell at 414-333-1936.

I promise we'll have some fun when the work is done.
